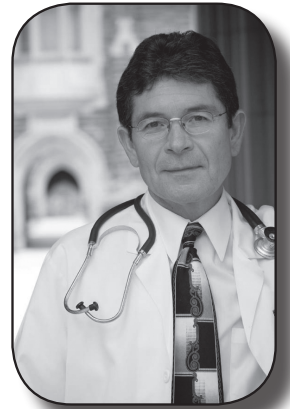

Saturday Keynote Speaker

Harold G. Koenig, MD

Harold G. Koenig, MD is one of the foremost experts on the study of religion and health.

He completed his geriatric medicine, psychiatry, and biostatistics training at Duke University Medical Center. He is board certified in general psychiatry, geriatric psychiatry and geriatric medicine and is on the faculty at Duke as a Professor. He is also a registered nurse.



Dr. Koenig is founder and former director of Duke University's Center for the Study of Religion, Spirituality and Health, and is founding co-director of the current Center of Spirituality, Theology and Health at Duke University Medical Center.

He has published extensively in the fields of mental health, geriatrics, and religion, with over 300 scientific peer-reviewed articles and book chapters and 40 books in print or in preparation.

His research on religion, health and ethical issues in medicine has been featured on over 50 national and international TV news programs (including The Today Show, ABC's World News Tonight, and several times on Good Morning America), and over 80 national or international radio programs.

In September 2008 Dr. Koenig was invited to give testimony before the U.S. House of Representatives concerning the benefits of religion and spirituality on health.
